

The Names of Jesus

“Those who know Your name will put their trust in You, for You, Lord, have not abandoned those who seek You.”
– Psalm 9:10

1. **Adonai** (Genesis 15:2, 8; Isaiah 25:2, 8) – Jesus is Lord of all
2. **Advocate** (1John 2:1) – Jesus is our defender against the accuser in God’s courtroom
3. **Almighty** (Exodus 5:22-6:8; Revelation 1:8, 19:15) – Jesus is great in power; a strong and powerful God
4. **Alpha and Omega** (Revelation 21:6, 22:13) – Jesus is the beginning: the source of all things; and Jesus is the end: the goal of all things, the consummation of all things
5. **The Amen** (Revelation 3:14) – Everything Jesus said is guaranteed to be firm, fixed, certain, faithful, trustworthy, and true
6. **Anchor of the Soul** (Hebrews 6:19; John 14:1-4) – Jesus has already gone ahead of us and He has secured a place for us
7. **Author and Finisher of our Faith** (Hebrews 12:2) – Jesus created our faith, He holds it in place, and He grows it to completion
8. **The Beginning of the creation of God** (John 1:1-3; Colossians 1:18; Revelation 3:14) – Jesus is the source of everything that is; He is the power by which creation began
9. **The Blessed and Only Sovereign** (1Timothy 6:15) – Jesus is peerless, matchless in power & authority; He is supremely & independently ruling over everything, everywhere
10. **Bread of Life** (John 6:35) – Jesus is the “Bread” that supplies life; He is *the* way to eternal life
11. **Bright Morning Star** (Revelation 22:16) – Jesus is the bright star that signals the “New Day”
12. **Chief Shepherd** (1Peter 5:4) – Jesus is the Head Shepherd, the Main Shepherd
13. **Cornerstone** (Ephesians 2:20) – Jesus is what everything in our lives is founded on and fixed to
14. **Dayspring** (Luke 1:78) – Jesus is the one who rises up and breaks through the spiritual darkness of this world; He brings the light of life to His peoples’ souls
15. **The Door** (John 10:9) – Jesus is *the* Door to Heaven
16. **Eternal Father** (Isaiah 9:6) – Jesus will be a Father to His people for eternity
17. **Faithful and True Witness** (Revelation 3:14) – The testimony of Jesus never fails to be reliable and true
18. **The Firstborn of All Creation** (Colossians 1:15) – Jesus is God’s preeminent Son, who possesses the right of inheritance and position over all creation
19. **The Firstborn from the Dead** (Colossians 1:18) – Jesus was the first to conquer spiritual death; He also conquered physical death
20. **Good Shepherd** (John 10:11) – Jesus laid down His own life for His sheep
21. **Great Shepherd** (Hebrews 13:20) – Jesus equips us in this life to do His will
22. **Head of the Body/Church** (Ephesians 5:23; Colossians 1:18) – Jesus has the role of authority, headship, and leadership of the church
23. **High Priest** (Hebrews 4:14-16) – Jesus is the sinless High Priest who has come to us from Heaven after making the one, perfect, final sacrifice for our sins; He can sympathize with us
24. **Holy and Righteous One** (Acts 3:14) – Through Jesus, your relationship with God is right
25. **Holy One of God** (Mark 1:24) – Jesus is holy as the Father is holy; He is a man without sin
26. **Holy One of Israel** (Isaiah 12:6; 48:17) – A future generation of God’s nation will one day worship their Holy Savior
27. **The Image of the Invisible God** (Colossians 1:15) – Jesus is the exact representation of God; He is the manifestation of God
28. **Immanuel** (Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:23) – God came to us in person; “God with us”
29. **Jesus** (Matthew 1:21) – “Savior” or “the Lord is Salvation”
30. **Judge** (Acts 10:42; 1Peter 4:5) – Jesus is the Judge of all generations; all of the unsaved, currently alive or dead, will be brought before Him
31. **King of Kings and Lord of Lords** (1Timothy 6:15; Revelation 19:16) – Jesus is the King above all other kings, the Ruler above of all world rulers

32. **King of the Jews** (*Mark 15:26*) – The inscription above Jesus on His cross
33. **Lamb of God** (*John 1:29; Revelation 21:23*) – Refers to Jesus' ultimate sacrifice on the cross to atone for the sins of the world
34. **Lamp of Heaven** (*Revelation 21:23*) – Jesus will light up the whole universe
35. **Light of the World** (*John 8:12; 9:5; 12:35*) – Jesus is the Light that has come into the dark world, exposing its blindness; He is the one who turns the light on in a person's heart and soul when they believe in Him
36. **Lion of the Tribe of Judah** (*Genesis 49:8-12; Revelation 5:5*) – Judah was the noblest and most victorious of the kingly tribe; speaks of Jesus' fierceness and strength during His Second Coming
37. **Living Stone** (*1Peter 2:4*) – Jesus is alive from the dead and has a living relationship with saved humanity
38. **Lord of All** (*Acts 10:36; Romans 10:12*) – Jesus is not just the Lord of Israel, but the Lord of the whole world
39. **Man of Sorrows** (*Isaiah 53:3*) – In His sorrow was our salvation
40. **Mediator** (*1Timothy 2:5*) – Jesus is the only mediator who can restore peace between God and sinners
41. **Messiah** (*Daniel 9:25; Matthew 1:1*) – Jesus is the promised deliverer of the Jewish nation prophesied in the Old Testament; "anointed one"
42. **Mighty God** (*Isaiah 9:6*) – Predicts the ultimate victory of Jesus over sin for His people
43. **Only Begotten Son** (*John 3:16*) – Jesus and the Father share the same divine nature as God
44. **Prince of Peace** (*Isaiah 9:6*) – There will be world peace under the rule of Jesus one day; His peace rules in every believer's heart today
45. **Prophet** (*Matthew 21:11; Mark 6:15*) – Many people during Jesus' time on earth would not accept His claim to be the Son of God, but some were willing to call Him a prophet, like Moses or Isaiah
46. **Redeemer** (*Job 19:25; Psalm 78:35; Isaiah 48:17; Galatians 3:13*) – Jesus paid the ransom for our sin with His blood, thereby freeing us from slavery to sin
47. **Resurrection and the Life** (*John 11:25*) – Even though you will die physically, if you believe in Jesus, you will live in eternity with God in Heaven
48. **Rock** (*1Corinthians 10:4*) – Jesus is the spiritual Rock who provides all that we need
49. **The Root and the Descendant of David** (*Revelation 22:16*) – Jesus fulfills all of God's promises in the OT
50. **Savior of the Body** (*Ephesians 5:23*) – Jesus is constantly concerned with our salvation, our protection, our purity, our maturation, and our preservation
51. **Savior of the World** (*John 4:42*) – Jesus is the Savior of anyone in the world who will call upon His name in faith
52. **Servant** (*Isaiah 42:1; Matthew 12:18; Acts 3:26; Acts 4:27*) – Jesus came here to serve the Father...to minister in the Father's name for the Father's purposes
53. **Shepherd and Guardian of Your Souls** (*1Peter 2:25*) – Jesus is the Pastor and Protector of our soul
54. **Son of David** (*Matthew 9:27*) – Jesus' "Jewish name" that shows us that He came from the ancestral line of David, as prophesied
55. **Son of God** (*Matthew 8:29*) – Jesus' "divine name" that shows us that He is indeed God
56. **Son of Man** (*Matthew 8:20; 20:28*) – Jesus' "mission name" that links Him to the reason why He came to earth: to suffer and die for our sin
57. **Teacher/Master** (*Matthew 8:19; John 3:2*) – Jesus was a teacher who imparted wisdom about God, man, sin, the world, and heaven to people
58. **True Vine** (*John 15:1, 5*) – Jesus is the perfect, real vine that all branches must stick to in order for them to produce godly fruit
59. **The Way, the Truth, the Life** (*John 14:6*) – The way to eternal life, the way to the Father, the way to Heaven is Jesus; His gospel is true and real; and Jesus joins His divine life with ours, both now & eternally
60. **Wonderful Counselor** (*Isaiah 9:6*) – Jesus will be a King who will dispense divine counsel, wonderful wisdom as He rules
61. **The Word** (*John 1:1-3, 14*) – Jesus is the one who is behind all of our reasoning, thinking, and creating
62. **Yahweh/I AM** (*Exodus 3:13-15; John 8:58*) – "I AM WHO I AM;" "Lord of All"
